**Curriculum Author-type tabs:** User selects tab to display the curriculum authored by the corresponding user type:

- My curriculum:** courses/units created by the user
- My peers:** courses/units created by other users in the subscription with the same subject and grade parameters set in their user profile
- My school:** courses/units created by all users in the school/subscription
- Master Curriculum:** all courses/units classified as "Master" by or for the school/subscription
- Featured:** courses/units created by Authentic Education or other third-party and made available through the subscription to use as reference or for use as a template for duplication. Can extend this to show courses/units made available for purchase under tertiary sub-tab "Curriculum/Featured/Shop".
- Archive:** courses and/or units moved to the archive by the user, the user's peers and/or school/subscription.

**Pagination:** User selects page number, "Prev" or "Next" to review results for that page. Appearance of page number for results displayed appears selected and is not clickable. First and last page numbers display preceded by "..." to facilitate quick jump to beginning/end. Defaults to showing 10 results per page. Can consider adding the ability to "Display 10 | 25 | 50" per page.

**Sub-Tab Filters:** User selects the results filter for the relevant courses/units for the author-type tab selected above (My curriculum, My Peers, My School):

- Recently Edited:** (Default) Displays courses with units that have recently been updated. Sorts results by most recently updated at the top.
- Today:** Displays today's date in tab text. Results display courses with units that are scheduled for today. Sorts results alphabetically by course name at the top.
- Upcoming:** Displays courses with units that are scheduled to start after today. Sorts results first by most recent start date at the top (those with same start date are sorted within alphabetically by course name).
- Past:** Displays courses with units that are scheduled to end prior to today. Sorts results first by most recent end date at the top (those with same end date are sorted within alphabetically by course name).
- All Courses:** Displays all courses alphabetically by name.

**Course:** User clicks Course Name or surrounding row to expand and display units for that course. Once expanded, user selects course or unit name to open course/unit detail page.

- Course/Unit utility:**
- Edit:** opens unit detail view (editable)
  - ▶** opens modal with the following options:
    - Copy:** copies course or unit, appending title with " Copy"
    - Schedule:** opens date modal to schedule unit. If unit has already been scheduled it shows as "Reschedule".
    - Add Author:** opens modal to add author/designer
    - Create Master:** creates a master copy of the unit and moves it to "Master Curriculum" and is made available to the users in the subscription
    - Archive:** moves this into the "Archive".
    - Create MS Word Archive:** opens modal which explains this functionality and includes a button to add this to the queue for converting to .DOCX file.

**Search by CCSS tab:** Displays preliminary parameter to be set for each type.
